General Information

Timeliness

- APHIS/CDC Form 2 Section 3 must be completed by the recipient within 2 business days of receipt
- APHIS/CDC Form 3 must be submitted within 7 days of theft, loss, release discovery of a select agent or toxin
- APHIS/CDC Form 4 must be submitted within 7 days of identification of a select agent of toxin

Notifications

- If a select agent or toxin shipment results in a theft, loss, or release, the recipient must immediately notify FSAP
- Any theft, loss or release of select agent or toxin requires immediate notification to FSAP
- All tier 1 select agent and toxin identifications require immediate notification to FSAP
